**I: STARTER**

Rosewater scented warm washcloths

Crunchy: Frying bacon/speck (set inside the door to the room)  
jack fruit chips & toasted corn  
Wine, water

**II: Hands (individual)**

Spicy & sweet: curried shortbreads with schwartzkummel and Ethiopian beri beri powder  
Pungent: ripe gooey cheese- gorgonzola, münster  
Crispy & Earthy: Baked kale chips with miso  
Gooey & smoky: date stuffed with mascarpone and Spanish smoked paprika  
Stuffed surprise: dried fig stuffed with shiro leaf and almond  
Slippery & sour: white fungus with umobeshi and grapefruit juice

**III: Bowls: spoons**

Creamy & aromatic: Saffron Risotto with toasted almonds  
Surprising, contrast: frozen pomegranite seeds

**IV: Passed: hands (group)**

Silken: Turkish pistachio candy floss  
Cold & strong: Vietnamese coffee popcicle
